#### Almost half of road fatalities occur in organisations´ supply chains









## Speeding

- 1/3 of fatalities caused by speeding
- Procurement low cost treatment
- Gradually increased requirements
  - 1. Number speeding tickets
  - 2. Random speed checks
  - 3. Monitoring
  - 4. Geofencing
