## A study for the Hässleholm–Lund rail section

### BACKGROUND

The Southern and Western rail sections are very congested and new capacity and more tracks are needed. Planning is underway at the Swedish Transport Administration for a unique undertaking to build a High-Speed Railway between Stockholm – Gothenburg and Stockholm – Malmö. We call this – A New Generation Railway.

The Swedish Transport Administration's assignment is to provide the government's investigation team, The National Negotiation on Housing and Infrastructure, with a knowledge basis and analyses for the expansion. This includes investigation, planning and implementation of the rail sections, that are required and decided by the government.

Two of our projects for high-speed double-rail sections are: The East Link between Järna and Linköping and The Gothenburg – Borås link. Furthermore two large feasibility studies are underway for the rail sections: Jönköping – Malmö and Borås – Linköping.

The Swedish Transport Administration is currently undertaking a study regarding the rail section Hässleholm–Lund which focuses on investigating and evaluating different production methods for more effective building of viaducts and embankments for high-speed railways. The study's purpose is to compare and evaluate costs for two alternative solutions and the result is expected to identify measures for more effective production methods.

In relation to this study, we at the Swedish Transport Administration would like to invite you to a workshop where you as suppliers are welcome to offer your insight and suggestions regarding this study.
