We are happy to announce that the Vision Zero International Course will take place in Gothenburg, Sweden, on the 16th – 20th of September 2024.

Road traffic injuries are a global epidemic that is recognized by the international community and is a part of the 2030 Agenda and the United Nations sustainable development goals (SDGs). In 1997, the Swedish Parliament adopted a 'Vision Zero' goal for road traffic, with the long-term goal that no one would be killed or seriously injured within the road transport system. Sweden has more than twenty-five years of experience of implementation strategies and interventions based on Vision Zero, which will be explained in further detail in the course.

The course is organized by the Vision Zero Academy – a part of the Swedish Transport Administration – in cooperation with several partners from both industry and research. All practical matters will be managed by the Swedish Transport Administration's Education and Training Center.

The course targets a broad audience and we welcome everyone who works directly or indirectly with road safety issues in various organisations such as government authorities, industry, municipalities, NGOs and academia, as well as for employees in international organisations with responsibility for public health and safety (UN, WHO, EU).
