The volume was distributed among approximately 1030 suppliers and organisations, large and small.

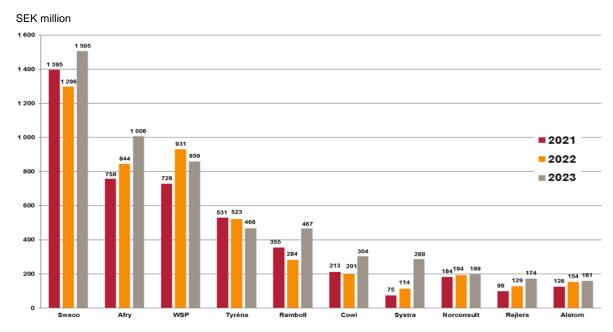

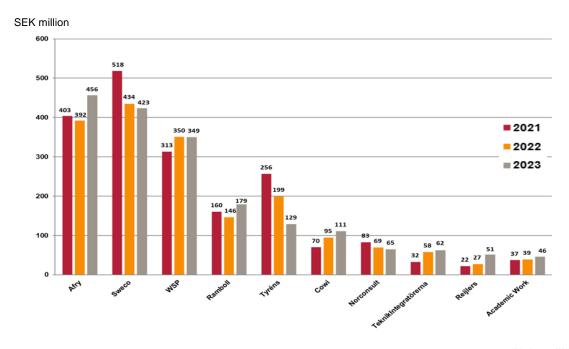

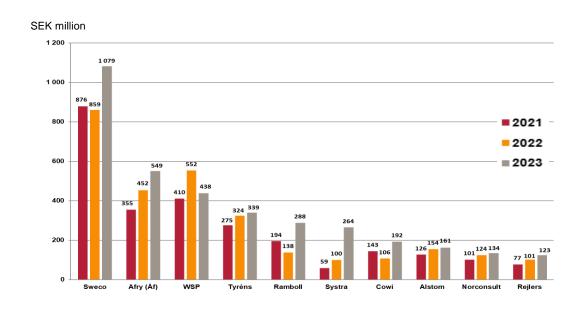
