## **Occupational health and safety in road safety**

In this session the mechanisms and consequences to internalize road safety in the obligations of the employer are presented and discussed. The international conventions on labor, the standards that are widespread and the new European Union Directive on corporate sustainability due diligence are all potential game changers when used for preventative actions.

## **Public procurement and road safety**

Public procurement is a large part of the global economy. When fully used, it can effectively support the community to build sustainability. In this session the methods, tools and principles for public procurement are presented and discussed.

## **Financial reporting and road safety**

With road safety as a sustainability issue in Global Goals, reporting the road safety footprint within each organizations value chain is now being on the agenda.
